- Times: The ferry leaves Stockholm on Saturday Aug 22 at 20:00 and returns Sunday Aug 23 at 18:55.
- **Cabin:** Book the cabin of your choice (1–4 beds, different price ranges).
- Buffet 20:30: This is where the wedding dinner takes place (all you can eat & drink). The buffet has room for max about 200 people book your spot in time!
- **Party:** After dinner we'll head out to the dance floor, karaoke and all the fun Viking Glory has to offer.
- Conference Sunday Aug 23, 13:00–15:00: Quiz, fun and speeches. If you'd like to give a toast or contribute something email us and we'll put you on the list (spontaneous surprises always welcome .)
