 Don't forget to bring a valid ID! Once onboard, everyone can take care of their own check-in and luggage before the festivities begin.

 The official wedding dinner will be held at The Buffet at 20:30 (Swedish time).

We are hoping to get our own section of the buffet and will let you know if we receive any further information from Viking Line. Either way, we'll all gather there for a truly pig-tastic evening of food, drinks and celebration!
